## Fall 2017 Paramedic Program

The IUP Institute for Rural Health and Safety announces the fall 2017 Paramedic Program. This program is primarily designed for future EMS personnel, but is appropriate for anyone who may respond to emergencies including fire/rescue personnel, nurses, coaches or athletic trainers, safety professionals, etc. Participants who successfully complete this program are eligible to take National Registry of Paramedics certification exams for PA and national certification as a paramedic.

**PREREQUISITE:** Students must be a certified Emergency Medical Technician

**COURSE REQUIREMENTS:** Course includes online components, lab and classroom, skill, and field sessions. Students must meet minimum physical capabilities of PA DOH. In addition, the student is also responsible for the following fees, not included in the above program fees.

- Successful completion of an EMT course approved by PA DOH
- Physical examination(s)
- Required blood work
- Drug screen(s)
- Parking at clinical and/or field sites
- Fuel for your personal vehicle to travel to and from class and clinical/field sites



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- National Registry CBE and any retests
- Any retest(s) or site fees for the National Registry practical exams
- Uniform: BDU pants, work boots
- Equipment: stethoscope, pen light, trauma scissors
- Lab Kit
- Clearances: Criminal reporting (Act 34), FBI fingerprinting (Act 114), Child abuse (Act 33)

**PREREGISTRATION** is required. Please go to [www.iup.edu/marketplace](http://www.iup.edu/marketplace) and Click the Registration Tab. Please complete the form and pay the \$50.00 **nonrefundable** by August 8, 2017. IUP reserves the right to cancel any program, at which time deposit/registration fees would be refunded. Enrollment is limited, however late registrations will be accepted if space is available.

## Payment:

1. *A minimum of \$1,000 payment is due when you are accepted into the program. (No later than **September 5, 2017**) This payment is non-refundable. Make payment at [www.iup.edu/marketplace](http://www.iup.edu/marketplace) Click the Deposit Tab.*
2. *A minimum of \$1,000.00 deposit is due before or on the first day of class which is **September 6, 2017**. This payment is non-refundable. Make payment at [www.iup.edu/marketplace](http://www.iup.edu/marketplace) Click 2<sup>nd</sup> Deposit Tab.*
3. *The remaining payment will be due no later than 90 days from the start of class. This date is December 6th, 2017. This is non-refundable. Make payment at [www.iup.edu/marketplace](http://www.iup.edu/marketplace) Click the Balance Due Tab.*
4. *Students must have tuition paid in full or have a signed payment plan approved by the program director in order to be eligible for graduation. If we do not receive the entire payment for the program, you will be turned over to collections.*

## Refund Policy:

We do not offer a refund for payments or fees made.

## Withdrawal Policy:

A student may withdraw from the program at any time through the completion of a signed withdrawal form. If a student chooses to withdraw from the program, the **student remains responsible to pay the tuition in its entirety**. See refund policy.
